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Country Context

- Population – 2,998,235
- Number of people living with HIV – 15,000;
- HIV Prevalence – 0.6;
- Number of new HIV infections (2016) – 1,600;
- Number of people newly-initiating art (2016) – 924;



Government

- creates the policy and legal environment;
- supports the active participation of PLHIV (laws and services);
- supports social and community awareness raising and mobilization;



Stigma and Discrimination

- low access to work and education services;
- avoidance of health care services;
- small coverage of HIV prevention programmes among key population;
- lack of interest for testing;
- hard to maintain patients for treatment;



Civil Society Actions

- advocates for the rights;
- influences the formation of priorities;
- brings and promotes new models of effective prevention;

Community PLHIV

- encourages and builds the capacity;
- intensifies education efforts;
- supports elaboration of informational materials;
- mobilizing for building the sustainability;

General population

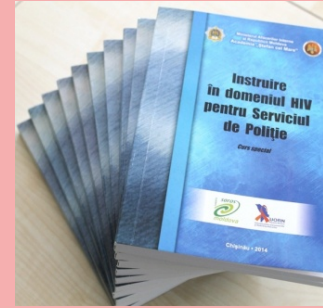
- organizes public awareness activities;
